

The Nevada Department of Transportation has initiated an environmental study to evaluate alternatives to improve safety and travel time reliability on Interstate 515 between Rancho Drive and Mojave Road.

## Project Need



- > Address aging infrastructure
- > Resolve poor freeway operations
- > Improve safety

## Proposed Improvements

- > Replace or remove the 1.6-mile viaduct (bridge)
- > Fix ramp spacing with ramp braiding to/from I-15 and I-515
- > Add freeway capacity
- > Construct new High Occupany Vehicle (HOV) interchanges at City Parkway and Maryland Parkway
- > Enhance bicycle/pedestrian mobility

## Alternatives

As part of the environmental process, the following alternatives will be evaluated:

1. Recess the freeway below grade
2. Build a wider freeway at similar height slightly south of current alignment through Downtown Las Vegas
3. Build a wider freeway at similar height slightly north of current alignment through Downtown Las Vegas
4. No-Build: Don't improve the freeway beyond planned interim improvements
